State of Oklahoma

Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak serves Oklahoma with one shorter-distance train, the *Heartland Flyer* (daily Oklahoma City-Fort Worth, Texas).

During FY05 Amtrak served the following Oklahoma locations, which had a 22.3% increase over FY04:

Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak expended \$318,578 for goods and services in Oklahoma in FY05.

Employment

During fiscal year 2005, Amtrak employed 4 Oklahoma residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Oklahoma were \$194,098 during this period.

State-Assisted Services

The *Heartland Flyer* is funded by the state of Oklahoma. Oklahoma has made capital upgrades to the BNSF tracks in Oklahoma, serving to increase speeds to 79 mph over segments of the route and reduce running times for the *Heartland Flyer*.
